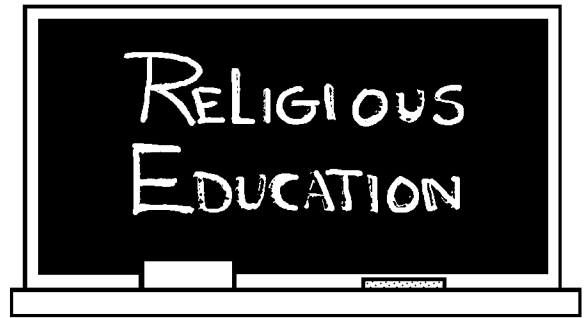
Every 2nd and 4th Wednesday of the month:
